RESTORED CORNER FOR OREGON STATE BOARD OF FORESTRY

One quarter corner common to Sections 3 and 34, Townships 1 and 2 North, Range 6 West, W.M., Tillamook County, Oregon.

## ORIGINAL

Stone  $12^n \times 12^n \times 6^n$  found in place,  $\frac{1}{4}$  on NE face, from which a:

18" Gedar bears North 1 lk.; now 24" burnt stump.

## RESTORED

Set  $1\frac{1}{2}$ <sup>10</sup> x 36<sup>10</sup> galvanized iron pipe with 3<sup>10</sup> bronze cap marked "OREGON STATE BOARD OF FORESTRY  $\frac{1}{4}$  S34 S3 1953 2311, 10 30 inches in ground, on North edge original stone, in mound of stone, and from which a:

46" Cedar stump bears S32½°W 49.7 ft., scribed ½ S3 BT
31" Fir stump bears N61°E 18.7 ft.; scribed ½S 34 BT RE 2311.

Also poster on white Cedar post 686.8 ft. East on fire break access road.

Also poster on white Cedar post 1791.7 ft. East on Rutherford Road.
