ORIGINAL

Stone 20" x 12" x 5" now in place 15" in ground with 4 notches on South edge and Innotch on East edge from which a:

- 48" Fir bears N60°E 38 lks.; now 50" stump, face not cut out.
- 15" Hemlock bears \$34°E 52 lks.; now 20" stub partially uprooted, BT scribes visible, scribes R7W \$13 on piece on ground.
- 70" Fir bears \$370W 10 lks.; now 72" stump, no face or scribes remaining.
- 12" Hemlock bears N59°W 61 lks.; now missing, point falls in skid road.

RESTORED

Erected mound of rock 3' \times 4' \times 10" around original stone, from which a:

- 60" Fir stump bears S75°E 56.4 ft.; scribed T3N R7W S13 BT.
- '55" Fir stump bears N37°E 41.8 ft.; scribed T3N R7W S1 S12 BT.
- 59" Fir stump bears S14W 55.6 ft.; scribed T3N R7W S14 BT RE 2311.
- 58" Fir stump bears N2°W 50.2 ft.; scribed T3N R7W S11 BT.

4" x 3" x 72" white Cedar post 1.5 ft. SE of pipe.

Also poster on 60" Fir stump, BT.
