24" Fir snag bears S23 W 15.5 ft.; scribed TlS R6W S19 BT. Also old scribes BM 2145.01.

40" Fir snag bears S69°E 39.5 ft.; scribed TlS R6W S20 BT RE 2311.

36" Fir stump bears N47°E 89.1 ft.; scribed T1S R6W S17 B^T.
