## ORIGINAL

Post, now missing, from which a:

20" Hemlock bears S6½°W 39 lks.; now 30" stub 20 ft. high, scribes S B visible, rest unexposed.

18" Hemlock bears N34°E 30 lks.; now 19" stub 6 ft. high, scribes 1/4 S BT visible.

## RESTORED

Set 1½" x 36" galvanized iron pipe with 3" bronze cap m marked "OREGON STATE BOARD OF FORESTRY 1/4 S14 S23 1954 RE 2311," 28 inches in ground, in mound of Stone 5' x 4' x 10", and from which a:

54" Cedar snag bears N20½°E 21.7 ft.; scribed 1/4 S14 BT RE 2311.

58" Cedar snag bears S64°W 31.0 ft.; scribed 1/4 S23 BT.

Oregon State Board of Forestry metal location poster on 54" Cedar snag BT.

4" x 4" x 60" white Cedar post 1.5 ft. SE of pipe.
