

CHAINS

RESTORED CORNER FOR OREGON STATE BOARD OF FORESTRY

Section corner common to Sections 35, 36, 1 and 2  
T's 1 and 2 N, R6W, W.M., Tillamook County, Oregon.

ORIGINAL

Post, now missing, from which a:

- 8" Cedar bears N31°E 9 lks.; now 9" uproot, cast of BT scribes remaining.
- 8" Cedar bears S18°E 25 lks.; now 11" uproot, badly burned.
- 6" Cedar bears N52°W 14 lks.; now just root hole remaining.
- 15" Cedar bears S30°W 43 lks.; now 23" partially uprooted, badly burnt.

RESTORED

Set 1½" x 36" galvanized iron pipe with 3" bronze cap marked "OREGON STATE BOARD OF FORESTRY T2N R6W S36 S35 S1 S2 T1N 1954 RE 2311," 32 inches in ground, and from which a:

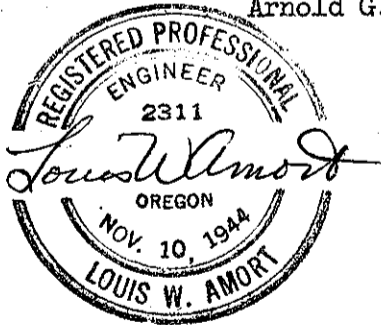
- 6" Fir bears S14°E 38.0 ft.; scribed T1N R6W S1 BT.
- 6" Fir bears S43°W 46.8 ft.; scribed T1N R6W S2 BT.
- 26" Fir stump bears N15°W 14.5 ft.; scribed T2N R6W S35 BT RE 2311.
- 7" Fir bears N53°E 153.5 ft.; scribed T2N R6W S36 BT.

Set 4"x4"x84" white Cedar post 2 ft. NE of pipe.
