

## RESTORED CORNER FOR OREGON STATE BOARD OF FORESTRY

Section corner common to Sections 5, 4, 8 and 9,  
Township 1 South, Range 7 West, W.M., Tillamook County, Oregon.

## ORIGINAL

Post, now missing, from which a:

- 4" Hemlock bears N31°W39 lks.; Now 14" snag  
Scribe 5 visible, rest of face unexposed.
- 7" Hemlock bears S76°W 18 lks.; Now just roots left.
- 18" Hemlock bears S51°E 36 lks.; Now roots in place.  
24" log down hill out of place, scribes T1S R7 BT visible.
- 18" Hemlock bears N21½°E 207 lks.; Now 30" stub 6' high  
scribes 1S R7W exposed.

## RESTORED

Set 1½" x 36" galvanized iron pipe with 3" bronze cap marked  
"OREGON STATE BOARD OF FORESTRY T1S R7W S5 S4 S8 S9 1954 RE 2311,"  
34 inches in ground, in small mound of stone, and from which a:

- 60" Cedar snag bears N27°E 170.0 ft.; scribed T1S R7W S4 BT.
- 4" Fir bears N47°W 28.0 ft.; scribed X.
- 59" Fir stump bears S42°E 38.2 ft.; scribed T1S R7W S9 BT.
- 72" Fir stump bears S23½°W 78.4 ft.; scribed T1S R7W S8 BT RE 2311.

Oregon State Board of Forestry metal location poster on 59" Fir stump BT.

5" x 5" x 60" White cedar post set 1 ft. SW of pipe.

Tag on 4" x 4" x 48" White Cedar post 500 ft. N. of Cor on S Edge log Road.

Dated February 25, 1954.
