42" Fir bears S23 $\frac{1}{2}$ W 60 lks., now 44" stump,  $\frac{1}{4}$  S BT Scribes visible.

10" Hemlock bears N60°E 22½ 1ks.; now 12" uproot, badly rotted.

## RESTORED

Set the above pin in place, 13 inches in ground, and from which a:

8" Fir bears N59°W 16.4 ft.; scribed  $\frac{1}{4}$  S14 BT RE 2311. 8" Fir bears S73°E 26.1 ft.; scribed 4 S23 BT.
