Baseline Section corner common to Sections 32 and 33, TlN, RSW, W.M., Tillamook County, Oregon.

## ORIGINAL

Stone  $22^n \times 10^n \times 6^n$ , now missing (found  $7^n$  Alder growing in place), from which a:

14" Hemlock bears North 37 lks.; now 13" stub, 6° high, scribes BT visible, rest retted away.

66" Cedar bears North 43°E 20 lks.; now 70" snag with old burnt out face, no scribes remaining.

## RESTORED

Bark scribed the 7" Alder TlN R8W EL on N side, S32 on W, and S33 on E, from which a:

6" Alder bears N14°W 10.9 ft.; bark scribed TlN R8W S32 BT. 78" Cedar snag bears N34°E 48.4 ft.; scribed TlN R8W S33 BT RE 2311.
