RESTORED CORNER FOR OREGON STATE BOARD OF FORESTRY

North one-sixteenth corner common to Sections 29 and 30
T3S, R9W, W.M., Tillamook County, Oregon.

ESTABLISHED by U. G. Jackson, February 1913 (Platt)

16" Alder bears N37°15'W 36.9 ft.; now 25", bark scribes
N 1/16 CS visible.

RESTORED

Var. 21½°E

Set 1½" x 36" galvanized iron pipe with 3" bronze cap
marked "OREGON STATE BOARD OF FORESTRY N 1/16 S30 S29
1957 RS 359," 33 inches in ground, and from which a:

33" Maple bears S77°E 69.3 ft.; scribed N 1/16 S29 BT
RS 359.

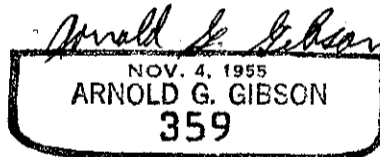
Original 25" Alder bears N37°15'W 36.9 ft.; scribed
