

CHAINS

RESTORED CORNER FOR OREGON STATE BOARD OF FORESTRY

Section corner common to Sections 29, 30, 31 and 32
T. 3N, R. 6W, W.M., Tillamook and Washington Counties, Oregon.

ORIGINAL

Post (found down with scribes S32 R6W S29 visible) from which a:

- 48" Fir bears N26°E 20 $\frac{1}{2}$ lks.; now 54" stump, faces unexposed.
- 60" Fir bears S31°E 21 $\frac{1}{2}$ lks.; now 54" stump, faces unexposed.
- 40" Fir bears S38 $\frac{1}{2}$ °W 36 lks.; now 42" stump, faces unexposed.
- 30" Fir bears N8°45'W 69 lks.; now 33" hollow stump, portion of scribe visible on edge of burnt out face.

RESTORED

Var. 21 $\frac{1}{2}$ °E

Set 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 36" galvanized iron pipe with 3" bronze cap marked "OREGON STATE BOARD OF FORESTRY T3N R6W S30 S29 S31 S32 1957 RS401," 33 inches in ground, in mound of stone, and from which a:

- 11" Fir bears N80°W 19.4 ft.; scribed T3N R6W S30 BT.
- 8" Fir bears N70°E 20.0 ft.; scribed T3N R6W S29 BT.
- 12" Fir bears S11°E 11.4 ft.; scribed T3N R6W S32 BT RS401.
- 9" Fir bears S14°W 27.4 ft.; scribed T3N R6W S31 BT.

Set original post on NE edge of pipe.

Oregon State Board of Forestry metal location poster on 11" Fir BT.

Also poster on telephone pole on N. R/W of S.P.R.R. approx. 685' S.

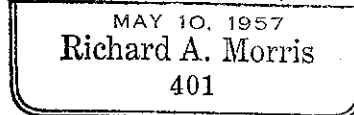
Set 4" x 4" x 60" white painted Cedar post 1.0' NE of pipe.
