30" Hemlock bears N55E 40 lks.; now 50" stump, scribe S visible on
 on partly exposed face.

24" Hemlock bears N34 $\frac{1}{2}$ W 84 lks.; now 44" stump, face and scribes cut
 off when logged.

Set 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 36" galvanized iron pipe with 3" bronze cap marked "OREGON STATE
 BOARD OF FORESTRY 1/4 S3 S10 1958 RS401," 33 inches in ground, in mound
 of stone, and from which a:

9" Hemlock bears S84E 15.6 ft.; scribed 1/4 S10 BT.

21" Hemlock bears N84W 36.8 ft.; scribed 1/4 S3 BT RS 401.

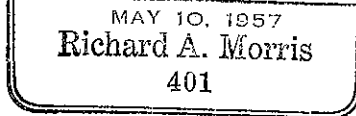
