

CHAINS

RESTORED CORNER FOR OREGON STATE BOARD OF FORESTRY

Section Corner common to Sections 13, 14, 23 and 24,  
T. 2S, R. 9W, W.M., Tillamook County, Oregon.

ORIGINAL

Post (now missing, point falls in old cat road) from which a:

- 30" Hemlock bears N30° 30'E 54 lks.; now 34" stump, scribes BT visible, rest unexposed.
- 20" Hemlock bears N30° 45'W 40 lks.; now 28" uproot, roots in place, scribes BT visible, rest unexposed.
- 7" Hemlock bears S52° 30'E 21 lks.; now missing, point falls in old cat road.
- 10" Hemlock bears S19° 30'W 22 lks.; now 17" uproot, roots in place, fallen on face side.

RESTORED

Var. 21½E

Set 1½" x 36" galvanized iron pipe with 3" bronze cap marked "OREGON STATE BOARD OF FORESTRY T2S R9W S14 S13 S23 S24 1958 RS401," 33 inches in ground, and from which a:

- 7" Hemlock bears N50½E 19.7 ft.; scribed T2S R9W S13 BT.
- 5" Hemlock bears S27E 10.7 ft.; scribed T2S R9W S24 BT.
- 48" Hemlock bears S53W 29.6 ft.; scribed T2S R9W S23 BT RS401.
- 5" Hemlock bears N83½W 25.2 ft.; scribed T2S R9W S14 BT.

Set 4" x 4" x 60" White painted Cedar post 1' S.W. of pipe.
