

CHAINS

RESTORED CORNER FOR OREGON STATE BOARD OF FORESTRY

Section corner common to Sections 33 and 34,
T. 2S, R. 9W, W.M., Tillamook County, Oregon.

ORIGINAL

Post (found 4" x 4" x 36" rotted Cedar post in place) from which a:

- 24" Hemlock bears S28E 55 lks.; now missing.
- 48" Cedar bears S20W 75 lks.; now 40" uproot, scribes and face rotted off.
- 128" Y. Fir bears N31E 57 lks.; now 88" snag, scribe T remains on rotted face.
- 104" Cedar bears N28W 50 lks.; now 80" uproot no face or scribes visible, roothole in place.

RESTORED by others (No record found at County Surveyor's office)

20" Alder bears N10W 13.0 ft.; scribed in bark T2S R9W.

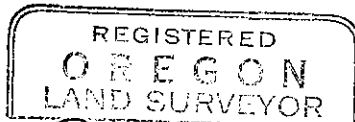
Set 1 1/2" x 36" galvanized iron pipe with 3" bronze cap marked "OREGON STATE BOARD OF FORESTRY T2S R9W S33 S34 S4 T3S 1958 RS401", 33 inches in ground, and from which a:

- 14" Fir bears N17W 61.6 ft.; scribed T2S R9W S33 BT RS401.
- 46" Fir bears N1E 81.0 ft.; scribed T 2S R9W S34 BT.

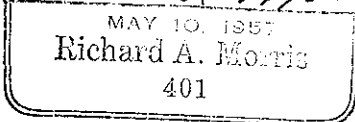
Oregon State Board of Forestry metal location poster on 46" Fir B.T.
