6" Alder bears N46W 17.9 ft.; scribed in bark N 1/16 S27 BT RS401.
96" Hollow Cedar stump bears S83 1/2 W 7.0 ft.; scribed N 1/16 S27 BT.

Set 4" x 4" x 56" white painted Cedar post 1.0' S.W. of pipe.

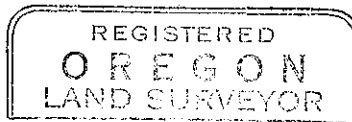

22" Hemlock bears S60 1/2 E 95.4 ft.; scribed CE 1/16 S27 BT RS401.

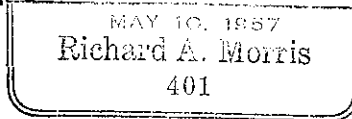
