

CHAINS

RESTORED CORNER FOR STATE OF OREGON-DEPARTMENT OF FORESTRY

Section corner common to Sections 10, 11, 14 and 15, T6S, R9W, W.M., Tillamook County, Oregon.

ORIGINAL

-Post (now missing, area torn up by logging) from which a:

- 30" Fir bears S77E 5 lks.; now missing, possible butt cut about 40 feet away, badly rotted.
- 24" Fir bears N55W 22 lks.; now 30 inch rotted out stump, scribes BT exposed, scribes on butt cut 30 feet away.
- 18" Fir bears N60E 63 lks.; now missing, displaced by road and logging.
- 12" Alder bears S49W 107 lks.; now missing, point falls in skid road.

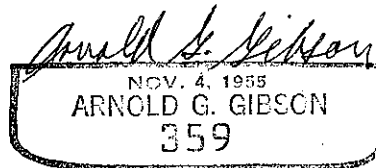
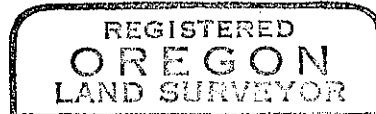
Set 1 1/2" x 36" galvanized iron pipe with 3" bronze cap marked "OREGON STATE BOARD OF FORESTRY T6S R9W S10 S11 S14 S15 1962 RS359", 30 inches in ground, and from which a:

- 10" Fir (N. side of road) bears N11W 57.9 ft.; scribed T6S R9W S10 BT.
- 9" Fir (N. side of road) bears N26E 50.3 ft.; scribed T6S R9W S11 BT.
- 10" Fir bears S30W 24.9 ft.; scribed T6S R9W S15 BT.
- 6" Fir bears S38E 67.0 ft.; scribed T6S R9W S14 BT.
- 5" Fir bears S15E 6.6 ft.; scribed RS359.

Oregon State Forestry Department metal location poster on above 5" Fir.  
Set 4 x 4 x 72" white painted Cedar post 1.5 feet NE of corner pipe.
