ESTABLISHED CORNERS FOR STATE OF OREGON-DEPARTMENT OF FORESTRY
(See official plat)
North One-sixteenth corner common to Sections 7 and 8, T1S,
R8W, W.M., Tillamook County, Oregon.

Set 1 1/2" x 36" galvanized iron pipe with 3" bronze cap marked "OREGON STATE
BOARD OF FORESTRY N 1/16 S7 S8 1962 RS401", 34 inches in ground, and
from which a:

- 18" Fir bears S32W 76.4 ft.; scribed N 1/16 S8 BT RS401.
- 18" Fir bears S61E 70.1 ft.; scribed N 1/16 S7 BT.

Set 4" x 4" x 60" white painted Cedar post 1.5 ft. NE of corner pipe.
Oregon State Forestry Department metal location poster on 5" Alder N79E
5.4 ft.

Southwest One-Sixteenth corner for Section 8, T1S, R8W,

20" Fir in place for corner, scribed SW 1/16 S8 on North face from which a:

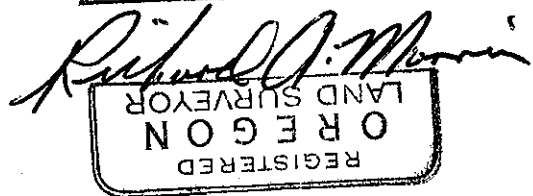
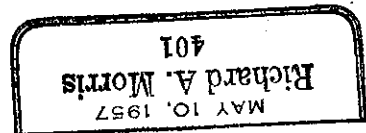
- 11" Fir bears S22E 12.0 ft.; scribed SW 1/16 S8 BT RS401.
