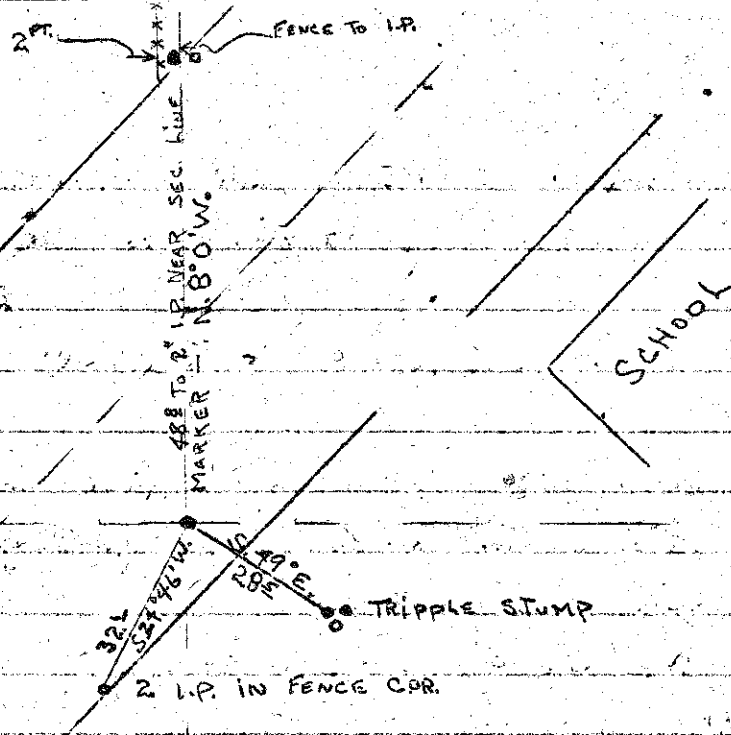

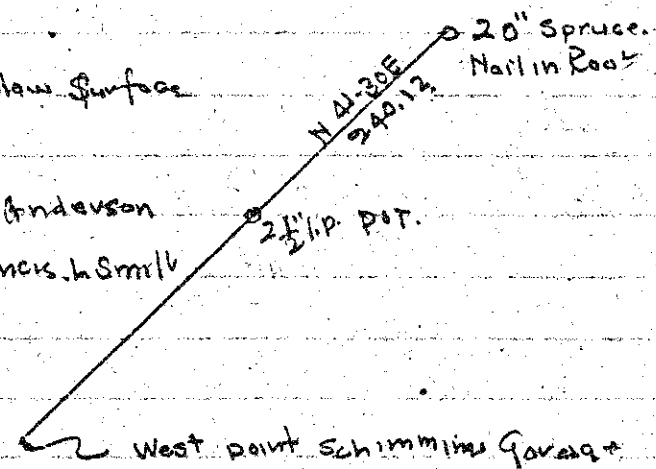

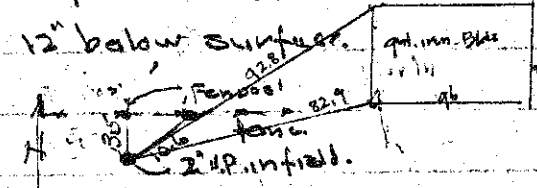

RD. WILL DESTROY 20" HEM. BEARS S 42° E. 105 IKS. TREE NOW 26" ALIVE - MARKS VISIBLE BUT APPEAR ON RIGHT SIDE OF TREE AS VIEWED FROM CORNER, NOT FACE

OUTSIDE CLEARING 24" HEM. BEARS N. 37° E. 50 IKS. NOW DEAD, BUT MARKS VISIBLE

24" HEM. BEARS N. 32° W. 45 IKS. - NO REMAINS TO BE FOUND

36" HEM. BEARS S 72° W. 45 IKS. - NO REMAINS TO BE FOUND

BT. MADE 15 TO 20 YEARS AGO (RECORD NOT FOUND) AS BELOW MADE NEW 20" HEM. S. E. 116' FT.
