I found a 3/4" diameter iron rod, center punched flush with the pavement. I set a 3" Tillamook County Surveyors brass cap on a 5/8" iron rod encased in concrete inside of a 10" cast iron monument case at the position of the found iron rod which I removed from the area.

History of Found Monument

The found monument is not the original monument set for this initial point; however, this monument has been used for the initial point in numerous surveys in the area and has been attributed to Tillamook County Survey map #A-1299; (see Tillamook County Surveyors map #A-4647 and A-4714). For original plat of this subdivision see Tillamook County Surveyors map #C-46.

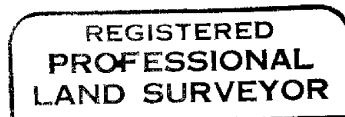
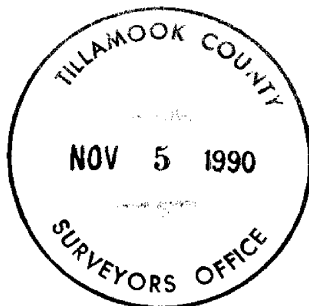
Location of Monument
