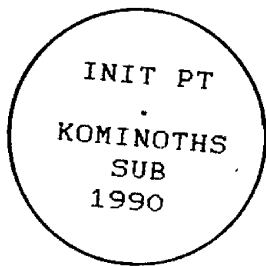


TILLAMOOK COUNTY SURVEYORS OFFICE

I found a 2" diameter iron pipe with a wood plug and "56" nail approximately 1" below the surface of the ground. I set a 3" Tillamook County Surveyors Brass cap on a 5/8" iron rod inside of the found iron pipe and encased in a irregular mass of concrete.

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History of Found Monument

The found monument is the original monument set for this subdivision, (See Tillamook County Surveyors map #C-313).

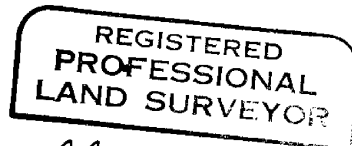
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Location of Monument

This initial point is located approximately 1.8' SW of a telephone stand, 1.5' SE of a guy anchor, 1.2' N.77\*W. of a fence corner, and 0.5' North of a chain link fence on the North side of a concrete curb in the roots of a laurel bush.
