

RESTORED CORNER FOR STATE OF OREGON - DEPARTMENT OF FORESTRY
4907 Third St., Tillamook, Oregon 97141

One quarter corner common to Sections 16 and 21, T2N, R7W, W.M.,
Tillamook County, Oregon.

ORIGINAL by Henry Meldrum, September 13, 1891.

16"x12"x8" basalt stone with 1/4 on North face; missing.

22" Hemlock bears S13E 97 lks.; missing.

11" Hemlock bears N69W 57 lks.; now a 9" x 4 ft. high rotted
stub with scribes BT laying alongside.

RESTORATION by Unknown, date Unknown.

6" squared post 6 ft. long 39' ft. NW BT; found, laying on ground.

RESTORATION by Bertell Mason, Jr. LS322, June 6, 1957 (Book 2, page 392,
Tillamook County Records).

Replace above post with 3/4" x 30" iron pipe; now rusted and loosely
set 0.9 ft. above ground.

46" Fir stump bears N12W 8.8 ft.; scribes 1/4 S16 BT visible.

36" Fir stump bears N86W 22.2 ft.; scribes 322 1957 1/4 BT
visible.

Var. 21 1/2 E

Set a 1 1/2"x30" Aluminum pipe with 3 3/4" cap marked "STATE OF OREGON
DEPARTMENT OF FORESTRY T2N R7W 1/4 S16 S21 1990 LS1998, 29" in mound
of stone, from which a:

9" Noble Fir bears N47 1/2W 22.4 ft. to face; scribed 1/4S16BT.

15" Fir bears S38E 20.1 ft. to face; scribed 1/4S21BT.

Mason's 46" Fir stump bears N23W 4.6 ft. to face.

Mason's 36" Fir stump bears S86 1/2W 22.2 ft. to face.

Mason's pipe bears S03 1/4W 4.5 ft.

Metal location poster on new BTs.

Also 1981 Crown Zellerbach posters on Mason's BTs.

3/4" brass washer marked "LS1998" nailed to face of new BTs.
