page 99, Tillamook Co. Records.)

1 1/2"x36" galvanized iron pipe with 3" bronze cap, 30" in ground, in
mound of stone; in place.

- 60" Fir stump, 20 ft. high with spring board holes to top bears
S30E 15.5 ft.; now badly rotted with scribes 1/4 S15 2311 BT
visible. Also letter D chopped on stump.
- 50" Fir stump, 4 ft. high bears N32E 38.5 ft.; now badly rotted
with portions of scribes 1/4 S10 BT visible.

From above pipe with marks "LS1998 1990" added, a:

- 7" Alder in clump of eight bears N46E 50.3 ft. to barkscribes
1/4S10BT.
