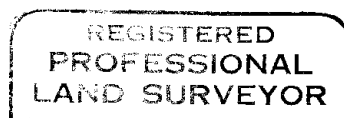
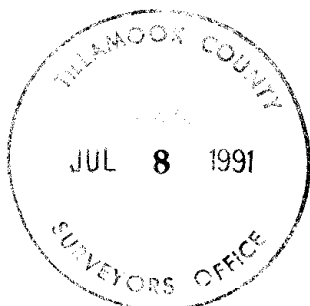
Monument Location
