One quarter corner common to Sections 15 and 16, T2N, R8W, W.M.,  
Tillamook County, Oregon.

ORIGINAL by Henry Meldrum, August 10, 1893.

13"x9"x6" basalt stone with 1/4 on West face; missing.

18" Hemlock bears N36W 22 lks.; now a 17" x 8 ft. high badly  
rotted stub with no scribes visible.

24" Hemlock bears S44E 45 lks.; missing.

1 1/2"x36" Galvanized iron pipe with 3" bronze cap, 36" in  
ground, in mound of stone; in place.

66" Fir stump bears N84W 47.9 ft.; now badly rotted with  
portions of scribes visible.

66" Fir stump bears N55E 46.7 ft.; now badly rotted with  
portions of scribes visible.

4"x4"x84" white painted Cedar post 1.5 ft. NW of pipe; in  
place.

Var. 21 1/2 E

From above pipe with marks "LS1998 1991" added a:

20" Fir bears N05E 32.4 ft. to face; scribed 1/4S15BT.

11" Fir bears S59 1/2W 7.2 ft. to face; scribed 1/4S16BT.

Metal location poster on new BTs.

3/4" brass washer marked "LS1998" nailed to face of new BTs.

Also metal location poster on 9" Fir on North side of Smith Wright  
Road bears S26W 68.2 ft.
