History of found monument

I found this monument to be as described on said T.C.S. Map and the references found and/or set at that time to now be as follows:

\*10" hemlock S.72 W. 27.2'; (Found, now 16" hemlock 26.77' to a finish nail with a brass washer in the partially healed face. Scribing visible).

\*5" alder N.47 E. 6.3'; (Found, now a 9" alder leaning downhill with stretched scribing visible N.34 E. 6.19' to a finish nail with a brass washer).

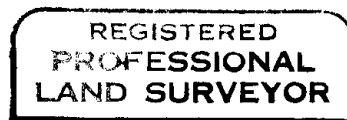
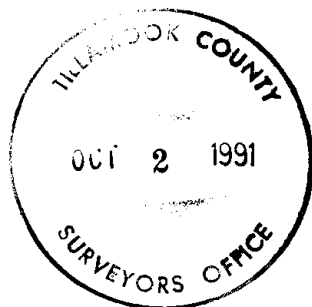
