I found a 2" iron pipe with a 3" Tillamook County Brass Cap (see T.C.S. Rewitness #802), approximately 4" deep, and 1' North of the Southerly edge of the pavement on Resort Drive County Road. I set an 8" cast iron monument case around the found monument and encased in concrete.

History of found monument

I found this monument to be as described in said T.C.S. Rewitness and the references found and/or set at that time to now be as follows:

24" culvert inlet marked "X" S.63°E. 22.57'; (Found, O.K.).

Nail in top of fence post S.20°W. 10.83'; (Now gone).

"X" in NE corner of house steps S.63 3/4°W. 140.77'; (Found, I did not check this reference; because, there is a row of very bushy ornamental trees between the corner and the steps).

*12" Spruce S.23°E. 27.08'; (Found, now a 30" spruce with healed face).

"56" nail NW 1.00'; (Not found, paved over, not searched for).

"56" nail NE 1.00'; (Not found, paved over, not searched for).

*90" hat section post South 7.1'; (Found, O.K.).

New Accessory

O. S. H. Brass Cap in concrete Bench Mark, cap is marked "S 690 1982" and bears S.14°W. 13.77' of corner, and a 96" hat section post with paddle board "USBM" bears East 1.7' of bench mark.

*indicates Tillamook County Surveyors yellow metal location poster attached.

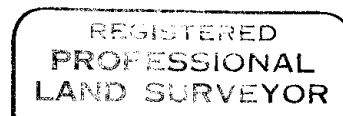
Location of Monument
