History of found monument

I found this monument to be as described on T.C.S. Rewitness Card # 732 and the references found and/or set at that time to now be as follows:

2" iron pipe in concrete and tile North 6.13', reported on T.C.S. Map #B-1047 as 6.68'; (Found, now leaning and broken, North 6.68', hit by a road grader, no longer a valid reference. Located on the East edge of the gravel at surface).

2" iron pipe in concrete and tile S.84°W. 12.85', reported on T.C.S. Map #B-1047 as S.84°W. 12.77'; (Found, now S.84°W 12.77'. Located on the West edge of the gravel, approximately 1" deep).

*84" hat section post North 1.3'; (Found, hit by grader and bent over. I removed, and reset straight portion, approximately 48" long, in North-South fence line East 3.04').

New Accessory

11" pine N.86°W. 15.58'. The distance was measured to a nail with a T.C.S. Brass washer in a small blaze in the South side center of the tree.

Power pole #115104 North 47.40'. The distance was measured to a nail with a T.C.S. Brass washer in a scribed triangle in the East side center of the pole.

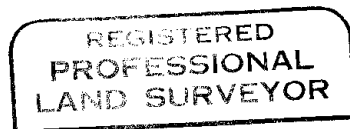
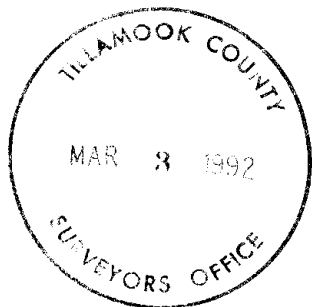
Location of Monument
