One quarter corner common to Sections 18 and 19, T1S, R6W, W.M.,
Tillamook County, Oregon.

ORIGINAL by Frank H. Sharp, June 24, 1893.
Post; missing.

- 8" Hemlock bears N05 1/2E 42 lks.; now a 15" x 3 1/2 ft. high
stub with no scribes or axe work visible.
- 10" Hemlock bears S53W 9 lks.; missing, point falls on cut bank of
old cat road.

RESTORATION by Arnold G. Gibson LS359, May 14, 1956
(Book 1, page 270, Tillamook County Records).

1 1/2"x36" galvanized iron pipe with 3" bronze cap, 34" in
ground; in place.

- 69" Fir stump bears N17W 61.2 ft.; now 3 1/2 ft. high and badly
rotted with axe work and portion of scribe visible on rotted
out face.
- 36" Fir stump bears S16W 17.0 ft.; now 5 ft. high and badly rotted
with scribes 1/4S19BTRS359 visible.
- 4"x4"x72" white painted Cedar post 1.5 ft. NW of pipe; in place.

REWITNESSED September 28, 1994 Var. 19 1/2 E
From the above pipe with marks "LS1998 1994" added, a:

- 24" Fir bears N22 1/2E 25.1 ft. to face; scribed 1/4S18BT.
- 19" Fir bears S76E 41.0 ft. to face; scribed 1/4S19BT.
- 14" Fir bears S48W 36.1 ft. to face; scribed 1/4S19BT.
- 11" Fir bears N84 1/2W 18.6 ft. to face; scribed 1/4S18BT.
(This BT falls on old cat road)

3/4" brass washer marked "LS1998" nailed to face of new BTs.

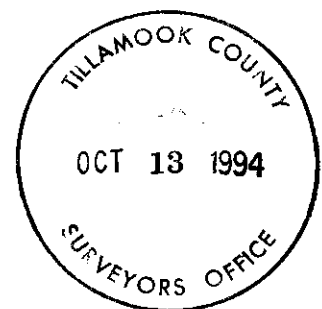
