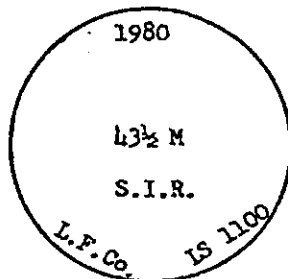
Found the following evidence which matches original G.L.O. notes:

44" Douglas fir stump bears N 25° E 11.22 feet (17 links); added yellow tag

Decadent hemlock blowdown bears S 20° E 11.22 feet (17 links) 1

Begin descent 264 feet (4 chns.) West

Set 1½" x 41" galvanized iron pipe for the corner with a brass cap marked as illustrated:



From which scribed:

9" hemlock bears S 10° W 30.45 feet; scribed "SIR 43½ M", screw nail, lead washer, yellow aluminum section marker plate

7' tall 52" fir stump bears S 74° W 9.25 feet; scribed "SIR RP", screw nail, lead washer, yellow aluminum section marker plate

Aspect: Gentle Northeast

Corner is 400 feet east of Salmon River Main Line. Power line is south 350 feet, course N 70° E.
