I found a 1 1/4" iron bar with a 3" Tillamook County Brass Cap (see T.C.S. Rewitness #384), approximately 1" deep, and ±2' West of a cattle guard at the east end of Mill Creek County Road. I set an 8" cast iron monument case around the found monument and encased in concrete.

History of found monument

I found this monument to be as described in said T.C.S. Rewitness and the references found and/or set at that time to now be as follows:

(Rewitness #384) power pole #P-29-L30-r8 N5°W 18.51'; (Found, now N8°W 18.57'. New pole number is 106701).

(Map A-293) 3" iron pipe South 10.00'; (Found, at position).

*96" hat section post S8°W 7.5'; (Found, Now S8°E 7.5').

This corner is located approximately 2' West of a cattle guard at the easterly end of Mill Creek County Road where it turns into a private logging road for Simpson Timber Company.

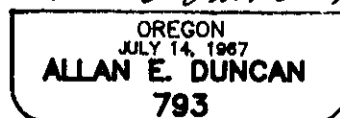
