- 12" Hemlock bears N25°E 15 lks.; missing.
- 8" Hemlock bears S40°E 26 lks.; missing.

1 1/2"x36" galvanized iron pipe with 3" bronze cap, 32" in
ground; in place.

17" Hemlock bears S57½°W 29.4 ft.; now a 12" x 6 ft. high
badly rotted stub with scribes ¼S4BTR visible.

18" Hemlock bears N32½°W 40.7 ft.; now a 23" uprooted
stump with closed face.

White painted Cedar post 1.0 ft. NE of corner pipe; in
place.

From the above pipe with marks "LS1998-1997" added a:

- 40" Spruce bears N32½°E 59.9 ft. to face; scribed ¼S33BT.
- 10" Hemlock bears S02°E 19.2 ft. to face; scribed ¼S4BT

- 26" Hemlock bears N27½°W 70.8 ft. to face; scribed ¼S33BT

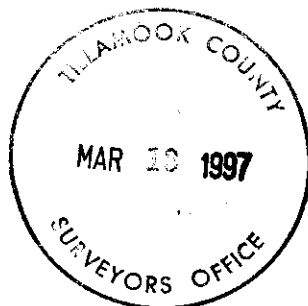
