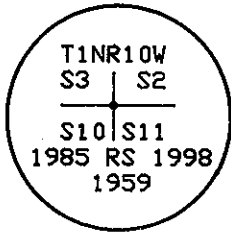

I FOUND A 1 1/2" IRON PIPE WITH A 3" D.S.B.F. BRASS CAP FLUSH WITH THE GROUND, (TILLAMOOK COUNTY SURVEYORS REWITNESS BOOK 1 AT PAGE 397). I SET A 10" CONCRETE CYLINDER AROUND THE MONUMENT.

(BOOK 1 AT PAGE 397) 23" HEMLOCK N.57 1/2°W. 42.4' REPORTED IN REWITNESS BOOK 6 AT PAGE 272 AS A 23" STUMP, 4' HIGH, SCRIBES "T1NR10WS3BT" VISIBLE; (NOW, 23" STUMP, 4' HIGH, NO SCRIBING VISIBLE).

(BOOK 1 AT PAGE 397) 20" DOUBLE HEMLOCK N.29°E. 10.8', REPORTED IN REWITNESS BOOK 6 AT PAGE 272 AS 20" STUMP, 3' HIGH, PORTIONS OF SCRIBES VISIBLE; (NOW, 20" STUMP, VERY ROTTEN, NO MARKS).

(BOOK 6 AT PAGE 272) 10" FIR N.41°E. 13.7'; (FOUND, NOW 12" FIR, FACE HEALED, AT POSITION, D.D.F. YELLOW METAL LOCATION POSTER ATTACHED).

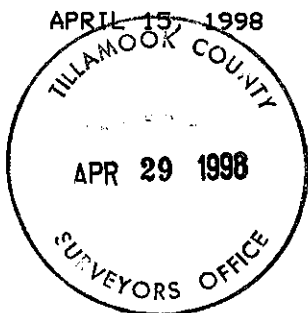
MONUMENT LOCATION
