One quarter corner common to Sections 20 and 29, T3N, R7W, W.M.,  
Tillamook County, Oregon.

ORIGINAL by Henry Meldrum, December 10, 1891.

Post; missing.

- 90" Fir bears S23°E 30 lks.; now a 84" x 5 ft. high rotted  
stump with chaining notch and axe work visible, no  
apparent face.
- 4" Vine Maple bears N37°W 6 lks.; missing, clump of Vine  
Maple nearby.
- 2 lk. Brook, course NE bears N89°54'E 3.43 chains; now  
220.5 ft. distant.
- 2 lk. Brook, course N bears N89°54'E 4.63 chains; now  
261.0 ft. distant.

Set 1½"x40" galvanized iron pipe with 3 3/4" bronze cap marked  
T3N R7W ¼ S20 S29 1999 LS1998, 36" in ground, from which  
a:

- 26" Fir bears N87°E 68.6 ft. to face; scribed 1/4S20BT.
- 33" Fir bears S06°E 54.0 ft. to face; scribed 1/4S29BT.
- 23" Fir bears S69°W 37.6 ft. to face; scribed 1/4S29BT.
- 25" Fir bears N04°W 60.2 ft. to face; scribed 1/4S20BT.

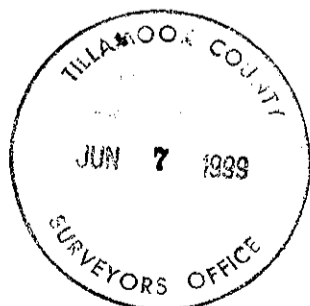
Metal location poster on new BTs.
