W.M., Tillamook County, Oregon.

ORIGINAL by Albert P. Wilson, June 25, 1891.

Post: missing.

- 14" Hemlock bears N71°E 70 lks.; missing, point falls in old cat road.
- 24" Hemlock bears S60°E 60 lks.; now badly rotted root crown.
- 20" Hemlock bears S58°W 16 lks.; now badly rotted root crown.
- 4" Vine Maple bears N40°W 43 lks.; missing.

RESTORATION by Louis W. Amort RE2311, November 25, 1952 (Book 2, page 191, Tillamook County Records).

1 ½"x36" galvanized iron pipe with 3" bronze cap, 36" in ground, in mound of stone; in place.

- 38" Fir snag, 75 ft. high bears S19½°E 56.7 ft.; now 40 ft. high with scribes T2S R7W S25 BT RE2311 visible.
- 50" Fir snag, 100 ft. high bears S49°W 101.4 ft.; now a stump with scribes BT visible.
- 60" Fir stump bears N77°W 113.5 ft.; now badly rotted with portions of scribes visible.

From above pipe with marks "LS1998 1999" added a:

- 20" Fir bears N19°E 38.5 ft. to face; scribed T2SR7WS24BT.
- 16" Fir bears S22½°W 29.7 ft. to face; scribed T2SR7WS26BT.
- 20" Fir bears S33°E 20.9 ft. to face; scribed T2SR7WS25BT.
- 15" Fir bears N73°W 16.2 ft. to face; scribed T2SR7WS23BT.

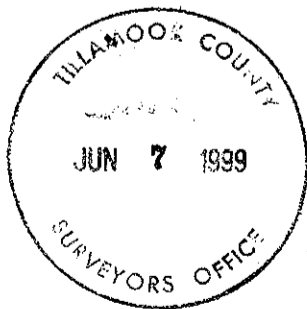
