4907 Third St., Tillamook, Oregon 97141

Section corner common to Sections 25, 26, 35 and 36, T2N, R8W, W.M.;
Tillamook County, Oregon.

ORIGINAL by Henry Meldrum, August 20, 1891.

16"x9"x7" Basalt stone with 1 notch on South and East edges; found a
12"x9"x4" broken Basalt stone with 1 notch, disturbed but at corner point.

- 60" Fir bears N50½°E 18 lks.; now 60"x5 ft. high rotted stump with
scribes T2N R7W S25 visible.
- 50" Fir bears S66°E 58 lks.; missing.
- 18" Hemlock bears S47°W 51 lks.; missing.
- 9" Hemlock bears N75°W 26 lks.; missing.

NOTE: Other 1891 corners for this township are known to be set from the BT
face.

ERRONEOUS RESTORATION by Louis W. Amort RE2311 December 11, 1952 (Book 2,
page 248, Tillamook County Records).

NOTE: Meldrum's 60" Fir (NE BT) mistaken for his 50" Fir (SE BT).

1½"x36" Galvanized iron pipe with 3" bronze cap, 30" in ground, in raised
mound of stone; now 40" in ground, in place.

- 66" Fir stub 8 feet high bears N48°E 11.4 ft.; now a 4 ft. high badly
rotted stump with scribes R8W S25 BT RE2311 visible.
- 54" Fir stump bears S34½°W 72.6 ft.; now 7 ft. high and rotted with
scribes T2N R8W S35 BT visible.
- 48" Fir snag bears N66°W 63.4 ft.; now a 7 ft. high rotted stump with
scribes T2N R8W S26 BT visible.

Set 1½"x40" Galvanized iron pipe with 3 3/4" bronze cap marked "STATE OF
OREGON DEPARTMENT OF FORESTRY T2N R8W S26 S25 S35 S36 2000 LS1998", 36"
in Ground, placed original stone on North edge and from which a:

- 15" Fir bears N34½°E 31.4 ft. to face; scribed T2NR8WS25BT.
- 13" Fir bears S78½°E 13.4 ft. to face; scribed T2NR8WS36BT.
- 14" Fir bears S36½°W 39.6 ft. to face; scribed T2NR8WS35BT.
- 20" Fir bears N76½°W 11.3 ft. to face; scribed T2NR8WS26BT.

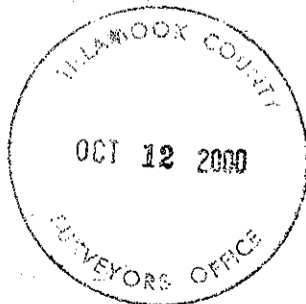
