RESTORATION by Louis W. Amort RE2311, June 19, 1958

1 1/2"x36" galvanized iron pipe with 3" bronze cap, 32" in  
ground; in place.

48" Hemlock bears N55½°E 105.0 ft.; now a 40" x 6 ft. high  
badly rotted stump with no scribes visible.

20" Hemlock bears S87°W 26.3 ft.; now a 21" x 3ft. high  
stub with portions of scribes visoble on rotted out  
face.

From the above pipe with marks "LS1998-2002" added a:

14" Hemlock bears N67°W 23.8 ft. to face; scribed ¼S32BT.

11" Hemlock bears N32°E 7.3 ft. to face; scribed ¼S32BT

14" Hemlock bears S20°E10.2 ft. to face; scribed ¼S5BT

9" Hemlock bears S41°W 12.6 ft. to face; scribed ¼S5BT

3/4" brass washer marked "LS1998" nailed to face of new Bts.

6 ft. orange Carsonite post on East edge of corner pipe.
