


Found Monument(s) and Accessories (Condition & Source): Found a 2" inside diameter iron pipe with a lead plug, up 0.3' in good condition. The monument is stamped as shown hereon. (Book 2, Page 461) – Found original 18" rotten Hemlock Stump, 3' tall, bears N 22° E 19.1', no scribing visible. (Book 2, Page 461) – Found original 20" rotten Hemlock Stump, 2' tall, bears N 31° W 19.8', no scribing visible. (Book 2, Page 461) – Found original Hemlock Stump, 3' tall, bears S 64° W 21.4' (S 66° W 23.1' slope), no scribing. (Book 2, Page 461) – Found original rotten stub, 6' tall and broken off, bears S 27° E 17.8', scribing partially visible. () Indicates record information from Rewitness Book 2, Page 461, Tillamook County Survey Records.

New accessories set: Set 120 lbs. of concrete in a 12" diameter cylinder around monument. Set the found 4" x 4" White Cedar Post at N 78° E 1.8' from corner. Set 72" hat section post with tag at N 10° W 2.0' from corner.		
New Bearing Trees set: 16" diameter Hemlock bears N 78° W 17.8', scribed "T2S R10W S30 BT", tagged and painted. 15" diameter Hemlock bears N 23° E 24.1', scribed "T2S R10W S29 BT", tagged and painted. 14" diameter Hemlock bears S 68° E 16.1', scribed "T2S R10W S32 BT", tagged and painted. 16" diameter Hemlock bears S 31° W 24.5', scribed "T2S R10W S31 BT", tagged and painted. All new bearing trees have a nail and aluminum washer marked, "Till. Co. Surveyor", in face of blaze, between the scribed B and T.		
Location & Comments: Corner is located approx. 80' West of North/South running, Whiskey Creek Mainline logging road.
