


Found Monument(s) and Accessories (Condition & Source): Found a 3" O.S.B.F. Brass Cap protruding 0.6', leaning slightly, plumbed and rotated cap North. The monument is stamped as shown hereon. Tied the monument conventionally using GPS established control. The Oregon North Zone State Plane in NAD 83/91 grid coordinate position for the monument is N = 601300.089, E = 7336163.784, U.S. Feet. Found a carsonite post South 6.0' of the monument. (G.L.O.) – Did not find the (6" dia. Vine Maple for corner, marked on W face "1/4 S"). (G.L.O.) – Did not find the (8" diameter Vine Maple bearing N 6° W 5 lks.). (G.L.O.) – Did not find the (6" diameter Vine Maple bearing S 2° W 18 lks.). (Map B-505) – Found rotten Hemlock Stump (was 35" dia.), 5' tall, bearing (N 67 3/4° W 58.2'), with rusty metal location tag. (Map B-505) – Found rotten Hemlock Stump (was 34" dia.), 5' tall, bearing S 11° E 17.7' (S 14 1/2° E 16.4'), hill is eroding, causing stump to lean and slide. (Map B-505) – Found 1" dia. Iron Pipe, leaning and disturbed, Northeasterly 8.1' (N 35°27' E 9.35'). () Indicates record information from Tillamook County Survey Records.		
Monument Set (Procedures and Description): Not applicable.		Sketch of Found Monument: 
New accessories set: Set 120 lbs. of concrete in a 12" dia. cylinder around monument. Reset carsonite post easterly 2.5' from monument. Set 72" hat section post with a yellow metal location poster North 3.0' from monument. Set a 5/8" X 30" iron rod with a red plastic cap marked, "Tillamook Co. Survey", for occupy point to conventionally tie the monument. The Oregon North Zone State Plane grid coordinate in NAD 83/91 is N = 601402.764, E = 7336208.443, US Feet. Set a 5/8" X 30" iron rod with a red plastic cap marked, "Tillamook Co. Survey", as a backsight point to conventionally tie the monument. The Oregon North Zone State Plane in NAD 83/91 grid coordinate for said point is N = 601391.220, E = 7336319.251, US Feet.		
New Bearing Trees set: 14" dia. Fir bearing N 40° W 24.2', scribed, "T3S R10W 1/4 S35 BT", tagged and painted. 18" dia. Hemlock bearing N 17°30' E 21.6', scribed, "1/4 S36 BT", tagged and painted. 12" dia. Fir bearing S 29° W 7.1', scribed, "1/4 S35 BT", tagged and painted. All new bearing trees have an aluminum nail and washer marked, "Till. Co. Surveyor" on the face between the scribed "B" and "T". All new bearing trees also have a yellow metal location tag affixed.		
Location & Comments: This corner is located approximately 75' east of an existing logging road.
