


Found Monument(s) and Accessories (Condition & Source): Found a 3" U.S.F.S. brass cap in good condition, up 0.5'. The monument is stamped as shown hereon. Found a white cedar post with a yellow metal location tag, lying down on the east side of the monument. (G.L.O.) – Did not find the (20" X 14" X 12" basalt stone) marked with 1 notch on the South and 5 notches on East sides. (G.L.O.) – Did not find the (12" Hemlock bearing N 58° E 30 lks.). (G.L.O.) – Found 3' tall pile of rotten remains (was 17" Hemlock) bearing (S 47° E 33 lks.). (G.L.O.) – Did not find the (16" Hemlock bearing S 24° W 68 lks.). (G.L.O.) – Did not find the (14" Hemlock bearing N 42° W 22 lks.). (Book 2, Page 154) – Found (48" dia. Fir Stump, 4' tall, bearing N 0°30' W 9.7', scribed "S30 BT") with a bearing tree tag. (Book 2, Page 154) – Found (56" dia. Fir Stump, 6' tall, bearing S 88° W 24.9'), no scribing visible, rotten face. (Book 2, Page 154) – Found (36" dia. Fir Stub, 10' tall, bearing S 58°30' E 41.8', scribed "T3N R7W S32 BT RE 2311"), tag. (Book 2, Page 154) – Found (63" dia. Fir Stump, 5' tall, bearing N 71° E 26.7', scribed "T3N R7W S29 BT"), with tag. (Book 2, Page 154) – Did not find the (29" Hemlock Stub, bearing S 47° E 21.5', with a metal location poster). New accessories set: Set 120 lbs. of concrete in a 12" diameter cylinder around monument. Set a 72" hat section post 3.0' West of the monument.		
New Bearing Trees set: 23" dia. Hemlock bears, N 21° W 7.9', scribed, "T3N R7W S30 BT", tagged and painted. 27" dia. Hemlock bears, N 76° E 18.2', scribed, "T3N R7W S29 BT", tagged and painted. All new bearing trees have a nail and aluminum washer marked, "Till. Co. Surveyor", in face of blaze, between the scribed "B and T" as well as a yellow metal location tag affixed.		
Location & Comments: Corner is located on a steep slope approx. 250' North of Northside Logging Road.
