


<b>Found Monument(s) and Accessories (Condition &amp; Source):</b> Found a 3" GLO Brass Cap, in tile and cement. The monument is stamped as shown hereon. Tied the monument directly using GPS established control. The Oregon North Zone State Plane in NAD 83/91 coordinate for the monument is N = 634432.515, E = 7363589.324 US Survey Feet. (GLO 1884) – Did not find the (18" dia. Hemlock bearing S 64°30' E 17 lks.). (GLO 1884) – Did not find the (15" dia. Hemlock bearing N 67°30' E 86 lks.). (GLO 1956) – Found 2 1/2" GLO Brass Cap marked, "T2S R9W S26 RM 1956", in mound of stone and a 12" diameter plastic cylinder and 120 pounds of concrete (N34°E 49.1' Rewitness Card #408), tied with GPS and now at grid bearing and distance N34° 10'48"E 48.79'. (GLO 1956) – Found 2 1/2" GLO Brass Cap marked, "T2S R9W S35 RM 1956", in a mound of stone and a 12" diameter plastic cylinder and 120 pounds of concrete (S74°E 26.29' Rewitness Card #408), tied with GPS and now at grid bearing and distance S74° 36'24"E 25.97'. (GLO 1956) – Found 2 1/2" GLO Brass Cap marked, "T2S R9W S27 S34 S26 1956", in a mound of stone and a 12" diameter plastic cylinder and 120 pounds of concrete (N0° 23' 43" E 246.2' Map B-404), tied with GPS and now at grid bearing and distance N02° 42'58"E 246.31'. ( ) Indicates record information, Tillamook County Survey Records.
