


Found a white painted cedar post lying near monument. (G.L.O.) – Did not find the (10" Hemlock bears S 10° E 12 lks. [7.92']). (G.L.O.) – Did not find the (20" Hemlock bears S 10° W 19 lks. [12.54']). (G.L.O.) – Did not find the (14" Hemlock bears N 31° W 18 lks. [11.88']). (Hays Book "F", Page 91) – Did not find the (20" Hemlock bears N 47° E 26 lks. [17.16']). (Book 1, Page 399) – Found 35" Hemlock, (was 16"), bears S 50 1/2° W 15.2' (S 47° W 14.7'), face healed, leaning downhill. (Book 1, Page 399) – Found rotten Hemlock Stump, 2' tall, (was 48"), bears (S 18° E 75.2'), no marks visible. (Book 1, Page 399) – Did not find the (8" Hemlock bears N 46° E 22.6'). (Book 1, Page 399) – Did not find the (14" Hemlock bears N 5° W 33.2'), (Book 6, Page 271) – Found 18" Fir Stump, 1' tall, (was 9"), (bears N 55 1/2° E 57.3'). (Book 6, Page 271) – Found 23" Double-topped Hemlock, (was 14"), (bears S 3° W 23.5'), face healed with a yellow tag affixed.
