<p>Found Monument(s) and Accessories (Condition & Source): Found a 3" diameter Tillamook County brass cap in a 10" diameter cast iron monument case in concrete. This monument was left at position as an underground monument. The monument was found to be in good condition. I then placed a 2" diameter Tillamook County Brass Cap in 60 pounds of concrete at road surface. The 2" diameter brass cap is stamped as shown hereon. Found a 60" diameter Spruce tree with face overgrown and with white and yellow bearing tree tags (was a 50" Spruce tree with face overgrown bearing S.31° E 59.88', see Rewitness Book 6, Page 499). Found a 48" diameter x 5' tall Spruce stump with face overgrown (was 44" Spruce tree with face overgrown bearing S.72° E 98.26', see Rewitness Book 6, Page 499). Added a yellow metal location poster. Found a 43" diameter Spruce tree with face overgrown and with a grown-in white bearing tree tag (was a 38" Spruce tree with face overgrown bearing S.14° E 128.55', see Rewitness Book 6, Page 499). Added a yellow metal location poster.</p>		
<p>Monument Set (Procedures and Description): We referenced the existing location of the found monument in the 10" diameter cast iron monument box with rock nails set in the asphalt. We then filled the cast iron monument box with concrete and placed the 2" diameter brass cap and 6" x 3/4" iron pipe in the concrete at the referenced position.</p>	<p>Sketch of Set 2" Diameter Brass Cap at Road Surface:</p> <div style="text-align: center;"> </div>	
<p>Other new accessories set: We replaced the damaged 96" hat section post with a new hat section post and yellow metal location tag at the record position of North 24.15', the record value from Rewitness Book 6, Page 499.</p>

<p>Location & Comments: This corner is located at the intersection of Bewleys Avenue and Baseline Road in Bay City.</p>
