| <b>Found Monument(s) and Accessories (Condition &amp; Source):</b> Original Corner was set by GLO in 1857. In 1970, a dependent resurvey of Section 17, T. 2 S., R. 10 W., was performed by Charles G. Collard, PLS #376 on Map A-1933, where he found the Original NW Bearing Tree along with a 1 1/2" Iron Pipe. He then reset the monument as shown below.  |                                     |   |
| <p>Found 2 1/2" dia. Crown Zellerbach Brass Cap, in concrete. Found Hat Section Post 1.0' Northwesterly of the monument. Found a white, painted cedar post lying down. Monument is stamped as shown hereon. The monument was then tied conventionally using GPS established control. The coordinates have been converted and are provided here in WGS 84, Latitude and Longitude.<br/>         North = 45°23'56.49946", West= 123°55'40.26333"</p> <p>(GLO) – Did not find the (36" Hemlock bearing N 45° E 16 lks.
