Found Monument(s) and Accessories (Condition & Source): Original Corner was set by GLO in 1857. In 1950, a dependent resurvey in Section 16, T. 1 S., R. 10 W., was performed by W.E. Anderson on Map A-446 where he found an unrecorded 1 1/2" Iron Pipe. In 1958, a survey was performed by John L. Carlich in said Section 16. He noted the same Iron Pipe as being on a line obtained from G. Collard (C.Z.) R.S. #376. Said Iron Pipe was then re-monumented by the Tillamook County Surveyor's Office in 1969 on Rewitness Card #285 as the historical position and is stamped as shown below.		
Found 3" dia. Tillamook County Brass Cap, in tile and concrete. Found Hat Section Post destroyed lying next to the monument. The monument was then tied conventionally using GPS established control. The coordinates have been converted and are provided here in WGS 84, Latitude and Longitude.
