

Agreement: Receipt of Abbott ID NOW System for COVID-19 Testing

OVERVIEW

Oregon Health Authority (OHA) and the COVID-19 Response and Recovery Unit (CRRU) is providing certain facilities with Abbott ID NOW Systems (System or Systems) for testing for coronavirus disease 2019 (COVID-19). The System includes:

1. An Abbott ID NOW instrument, a qualitative, rapid molecular test that utilizes an isothermal nucleic acid amplification technology to detect nucleic acid from the SARS-CoV-2 viral RNA (“Abbott ID NOW Instrument” or “instrument”),
2. Abbott ID NOW test kits with 24 tests (“Abbott ID NOW test kit” or “test kit”), and
3. Abbott ID NOW positive and negative controls.

PROVISION OF ABBOTT ID NOW SYSTEMS AND TEST KITS

1. OHA shall provide or has already provided the Receiving Facility named above (hereinafter “Receiving Facility”) with an Abbott ID NOW System and test kits.
2. Receiving Facility shall comply with all terms and conditions of this Agreement and any guidance from OHA regarding use of the Systems, including Abbott ID NOW Guidance incorporated herein by reference and attached to this Agreement.
3. Receiving Facility will not reallocate Abbott Device(s) to another Receiving Facility without first seeking approval from OHA of the reallocation and CLIA number of the new Receiving Facility.
4. OHA will continue to order and/or be automatically sent additional test kits and controls through IRR for distribution to the Receiving Facilities in Oregon.
5. OHA may order additional test kits after receiving resource requests from local public health authorities (LPHAs) or tribal authorities for the Receiving Facility if the Receiving Facility complies with this Agreement.

TERMS & CONDITIONS

1. The Receiving Facility and any testing site operated by the Receiving Facility using the System must comply with Oregon Administrative Rules (OAR) Chapter 333, Division 24, including but not limited to the requirement to be Clinical Laboratory Improvement Amendments (CLIA) certified or have a waived laboratory as described in temporary OAR 333-024-3000.
2. The Receiving Facility shall regularly check for revised or temporary rules. Updates to rules may be found at <https://www.oregon.gov/oha/PH/LaboratoryServices/ClinicalLaboratoryRegulation/Pages/index.aspx>.
3. Prior to testing using the System, the Receiving Facility shall consider the feasibility for standing up testing, including the training of staff, assuring safety, and establishing result reporting mechanisms.
4. The Receiving Facility shall test using the System in accordance with current OHA testing guidance available at: www.healthoregon.org/coronavirushcp.
5. The Receiving Facility shall consider and account for biosafety considerations when using or operating the System, including but not limited to:
 - a. Conducting testing using a biological safety cabinet (BSC) if available. If a BSC is not available, testing sites should consider use of biohazard shields or splash guards and appropriate PPE

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- including gloves, face shields and respiratory protective equipment.
- b. Strictly following good laboratory safety practices and routine disinfection practices.
- 6. The Receiving Facility may:
 - a. Contact OSPHL for technical subject matter expert support regarding biosafety and consultation for conducting biological risk assessments if needed to assure safety of personnel performing the test.
 - b. Request additional test kits through the governing local public health authority or tribal authority as applicable.
- 7. Charges/Billing:**
 - a. The Receiving Facility agrees not to charge for COVID-19 testing when using test kits provided by OHA except the Receiving Facility may bill insurance:
 - i. For the collection of specimens, but not for any costs of the supplies or instrument;
 - ii. A processing fee, but not for any costs of the supplies or instrument.
 - b. The Receiving Facility agrees not to charge patients for the cost of COVID-19 testing when using the instrument with test kits provided by OHA.
- 8. The Abbott ID NOW instruments distributed by OHA will become the property of the end user (Receiving Facility). OHA requests that Receiving Facilities promptly return any Systems or unused test kits provided by OHA to OHA or DHHS upon written request.
- 9. This Agreement may be executed through facsimile, scan, or electronic transmission. All faxed, emailed, or electronic signatures affirming this Agreement constitute an original signature.
