- 1. The National Day of Prayer is a tradition first proclaimed by the Continental Congress in 1775.
- 2. The National Day of Prayer was established as an annual event by a joint resolution of Congress in 1952 and signed into law by President Truman. The law was amended in 1988 and signed by President Reagan designating it as the first Thursday in May each year.
- 3. The Board of County Commissioners is grateful for the ecumenical work of the Tillamook Countywide Prayer Team in bringing Tillamook County citizens together to pray for our county and its citizens, the state, and the nation on this National Day of Prayer.

NOW, THEREFORE, LET IT BE RESOLVED, that:

4. The Tillamook County Board of Commissioners hereby proclaims Thursday, May 5th, 2022 as "A Day of Prayer" in Tillamook County and invites citizens to observe this day in ways appropriate and significant to their personal practices of faith.
