Should Nestucca RFPD issue a local operating levy for fire and emergency services for five years beginning in 2024 ? This measure renews current local option taxes.

Summary 175 words which concisely and impartially summarizes the measure and its major effect.

This measure if approved would renew authorizing the District to levy taxes to support the annual cost of fire and emergency medical services. The measure would provide for a local option operating levy at the rate not to exceed \$0.66 cents per \$1000.00 of taxable assessed value within the District for five years beginning July 1st, 2024. Revenue from the levy would be used to maintain adequate staffing with the goal of assuring adequate response time. The estimated revenue over 5 years is:

The number of calls for service has increased. The Districts goal with this levy would be to renew the existing levy supporting the nine full time line firefighters.
