

vote by mail

If you are registered to vote, you will be mailed a ballot approximately 2 weeks before an election.

- 1 Vote according to the instructions included with your ballot.
- **Return your voted ballot** by mail or to any: elections office *-or-* official dropsite in Oregon
 - Voted ballots must be received by 8 pm on election day

- → check or update your registration
- → register to vote
- → find an official dropsite
- → track your ballot

who can register to vote?

You can register to vote if you can answer yes to the following questions:

- → Are you a resident of Oregon?
- → Are you a US citizen?
- → Are you at least 17 years old?

where can I register to vote?

You can register to vote at:

- → oregonvotes.org
- → any County Elections office
- → the Secretary of State's Office
- → any Department of Motor Vehicles (DMV)



Last day to register:

21 days before election day

when should I update my registration?

You should update your registration if you do any of the following:

- → change your home address
- → change your mailing address
- → will be away from home on election day
- → change your name
- → want to change or select a political party
