This matter came before the Tillamook County Board of Commissioners on July 17, 2024, at the request of William K. Sargent, County Counsel. The Board of Commissioners, being fully apprised of the records and files herein, finds as follows:

- 1. A deed dated August 30, 2007, and recorded as Instrument #2007-007549, Stimson Lumber Company conveyed to Tillamook County Parcel 1, Partition Play 2007-21 (the "Cape Meares Property").
- 2. A deed dated October 3, 2007, and recorded as Instrument #2007-008506, Tillamook County conveyed to the Cape Meares Community Association the Cape Meares Property subject to that portion being and lying in Cape Meares County Loop Road.
- 3. Instrument #2007-008506 provided that said parcel is to be used for the creation of open space for perpetual public use pursuant to ORS 271.330(3), and the instrument did not contain a provision for the reversion of the property to the political subdivision if the property is not used in conformance with the restriction.
- 4. The Cape Meares Community Association intends to convey the Cape Meares Property to The Conservation Fund, a non-profit organization, as a bridge buyer to then convey the Cape Meares Property to the United States Fish and Wildlife Service for potential inclusion in the Cape Meares National Wildlife Refuge.
- 5. ORS 271.335 allows the county to waive and relinquish any reversionary interest in property transferred under ORS 271.330 when doing so is in the public interest.

## NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:

6. That to the extent any reversionary interest is held by Tillamook County under ORS 271.330(3), Tillamook County waives and relinquishes any such reversionary interest in the Cape Meares Property and declares that the 2007 transfer of the Cape Meares Property to Cape Meares Community Association was in the public interest, and the potential transfer to the United States Fish and Wildlife Service furthers such public interest.
